Selection criteria (in descending priority)

- 1. International students who must complete the German course according to their Learning Agreement.
- 2. International students who are (presumably) regularly enrolled at the UW/H. Preference will be given to the following in descending order of priority:
 - 1. Students who have already applied in the past but have not been offered a place.
 - 2. Students with no or only little knowledge of German (A1-A2).
- 3. If students apply for 2 courses, the 2nd course wish will only be granted if the place quota has not yet been exhausted and there are no other applicants who have not yet received a place. Non-general language courses are prioritised as follows:
 - 1. Courses from the fields of "scientific language" and "language for specific purposes", if the latter is clearly connected to the applicant's degree programme.
 - 2. Courses from the fields of "special courses" and "language for specific purposes", if the latter is not clearly related to the applicant's degree programme.
